

ESG - Sustainable finance update

During the last quarter of 2022, several pieces of legislation and other guidance documents related to sustainable finance in the asset management industry have been published by national and European authorities.

Amongst these are:

- the <u>CSSF FAQ on Regulation (EU) 2019/2088</u> on sustainability-related disclosures in the financial sector ("SFDR");
- the ESAs' Q&A on the SFDR RTS;
- the new <u>RTS on nuclear energy and fossil gas</u> investment disclosures under SFDR adopted by the European Commission;
- the <u>EU Commission FAQ on certain provisions of Disclosure Delegated Act</u> under Article 8 of the Taxonomy Regulation;
- the MiFID II product governance rules: <u>Integration of sustainability factors</u>;
- the ESMA <u>Guidelines on MiFID II suitability requirements</u> (final report);
- the ESMA Consultation on guidelines on funds' names using ESG or sustainabilityrelated terms.
